Harvey Theodore Winter went home to be with Christ on March 17, 2013 at the age of 83. He was born on October 17, 1929 in Beaver Dam, Wisconsin. He was the grandson of Herman and Augusta Winter who emigrated to America from Baden-Wurttemberg, Germany in 1891. He was the son of Emil and Martha Winter and the youngest of five children.
