



Alma Leopoldine Quidato

August 31, 1941 - October 22, 2014

Alma Gruell Quidato passed away peacefully on Wednesday, October 22, 2014 with her family at her side after a six-month battle against cancer. She was 73. Alma was born to Nikolaus and Anna Gruell in Freising, Germany on August 31, 1941. In 1962, she met the love of her life, James Quidato, who was in the American Army stationed near her town. After a yearlong courtship, James Quidato married Alma Gruell on March 8, 1963. They moved to the United States in 1964 and settled in Napa in 1972. Alma loved to travel, and the couple had close friends with whom they went on cruises and trips to Germany, Philippines, Hawaii, and Mexico. She was a 40-year member of the Napa German Club, and had many lifetime friends that she cherished. Alma is survived by her husband of 51 years James Quidato, daughter Karen Quidato of Sacramento, daughter Sandy Connelly, son-in-law Mike Connelly, grandchildren Anna and Reno, all of Klamath Falls, OR, and brother Nikolaus Gruell in Germany. She was preceded in death by parents Nikolaus and Anna Gruell, sister Heidi Gerlsbeck, and mother-in-law Vic Quidato.
