September 17, 1923 - May 28, 2018

Angelina Aguilar Carrillo (Malina), passed away on Monday, May 28, 2018 at the very young age of 94. She went to the arms of Our Heavenly Father peacefully surrounded by loving family. Our mom was known for all the love and devotion she showed to her 11 children, 47 grandchildren, 84 great-grandchildren, and 5 great-great-grandchildren, ranging in ages from 4 months to 80 years old. She was predeceased by her husband, Rafael Carrillo, and 6 of their children. Malina came to the Napa Valley about 56 years ago. She started as a housekeeper for the Pepper Family, and then worked for the Christian Brothers Camp in Calistoga as a fulltime cook. She then started working at the Oakville Grange, doing what she enjoyed bestcooking. If any of you were lucky enough to share her bounty, whether it was freshly made flour tortillas, her tamales that were to die for, or her simply buttered toast with a little sugar, consider yourself blessed. She also worked for many years in the vineyards, so that many of us could enjoy the fruits of her laborthe famous Napa Valley wines. She became disabled after hurting her knee while working for Vinifera Wine Industries. She then stayed home watching over many of her grandchildren and other children as well. Our mom also loved to travel, and she went on numerous vacations with different family members. On her last trip to Mexico she visited Cofrada de Duendes, Cofrada de Juarez, and Colima in the states of Jalisco and Colima. She also traveled to Guadalajara, Jalisco various times. Shes also visited many places around the country like Disneyland, Las Vegas, Nevada, Tucson, and Yuma, Arizona.

Sometimes a Sunday drive with our would turn into an adventure. One of those times we went hiking in Jack London State Park in Sonoma. And as if that was not enough, after our hike we got into the van and drove to the California Redwoods. Eventually we found our way to see one of her sons, Saul, in the Redway-Garberville area. What exciting times we all had with our Malina. On behalf of Angelinas family, we would like to give a very Special Thanks to all the nurses on the second floor of the Queen of the Valley Hospital for the precious hands and hearts that went out of their way to care for our mother. We would also like to give a Great Big Thanks to all the workers at the Meadows of Napa Valley who watched over our mother for many months.
