George Gosling, 84, passed away peacefully at his home on July 24, 2014. He was born on April 3, 1930, to Doris (Clark) and George Gosling, Sr. After growing up in Napa, and spending many summers working and playing in Monticello (now under Lake Berryessa), George attended UC Berkeley, where he received a degree in agricultural economics, and had a successful football career. After Cal, George attended Sacramento State, where he earned his teaching credential, and met his future wife, Charlotte Bissell. They married in 1959 and settled in Angwin. After teaching for 33 years in St. Helena and raising five children, George "retired" and started his second career. For the next 20 years, he worked in the tasting room at Beaulieu Vineyards, where he enjoyed the opportunity to meet new people and forge new friendships. Throughout his life, George enjoyed hunting and fishing, and for many years raised and bred rabbits. He was preceded in death by his parents, and is survived by his wife of 55 years, Charlotte, as well as his sister, Janice McKenzie, of Napa and his brother, John, of Rossmoor. He is also survived by his children, Julianna (Olaf), Cynthia (Tom), Stephanie (Blake), Jennifer (Jay) and Geo, as well as eight grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
