



Gordon Cutler Mathe

February 5, 1922 - September 4, 2013

Gordon Cutler Mathe passed to his rest on Wednesday, September 4, 2013 at the age of 91 after a brief illness. He was the first of three children born to Merle and Mary Mathe on February 5, 1922, in Almond, Wisconsin. The search for employment during the Great Depression led his family to St. Helena. Gordon served in the U.S. Army from 1942 to 1946 as a non-combatant Medical Corpsman. He married Wilma Bridwell in 1946, and the two remained in the Napa Valley where they both worked as nurses while raising their family of three boys. They moved from St. Helena to Napa in 1954. Gordon worked at the Yountville Veteran's Home from 1952 until he retired in 1985. He was active in the Napa Seventh-day Adventist church, and enjoyed trailer-camping, cruises, cars, and his grandchildren. Virtues that Gordon manifested throughout his life were hard work, integrity, frugality, dependability, and an uncomplaining attitude. He loved his country, his God, and his family. Gordon's wife Wilma preceded him in death in 2006. He is survived by sister Lois Booth, sons Glen (Paula), Wayne (Renee), Myron (Kathy), and grandchildren Michael, Alisa, Ashley, and Emily. There will be a memorial service on September 22 at 11:00 am, at the Napa Community Seventh-day Adventist Church.
