James Robert Dack, 72, passed away on Saturday, December 13, 2014. He was born October 26, 1942 to Orval F. and Mary (Cross) Dack in Portola, California. Jim's father died when he was 13, leaving him to be raised by his mother and stepfather, Elman Lofholm. Jim grew up in Portola, graduating from Portola High.
