Joyce Ann Diemer, Professor Emeritus, Napa Valley College, died at a local convalescent hospital on December 26th. Born in San Francisco to Dr. and Mrs. Raymond Shane (Helen), she graduated from Sacred Heart Elementary and High Schools, received a BA and Master's in political science from UC Berkeley, and taught political science at NVC from 1961 to 1991, serving as President of the Faculty Senate. In 1970 she married the former NVC President, Dr. James Diemer. For 13 years, until his death, they worked, traveled, and enjoyed politics and bridge. Sadly, Joyce suffered a debilitating stroke four years after retirement. Joyce is survived by her cousin Willett James Brown of Seiku, Wash., and friends Ross and Victoria Tuck of Victoria, B.C., and Dorothy Menzel and Dolores Fischer, both of Napa. The Rosary is Monday, January 6th at Treadway & Wigger Funeral Chapel; the Mass is Tuesday, January 7th, 10am, St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church. Burial will follow at Tulocay Cemetery.
