



## Lottie Lea Rosenberg

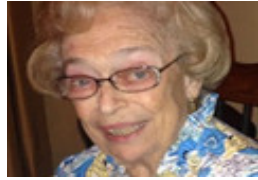
May 8, 1929 - August 15, 2014

Lottie passed away at the age of 85 on Aug. 15 in Peoria, Arizona. Born May 8 in Frankfurt, Germany, she immigrated to the U.S. in 1938 with her parents, Fred and Bella Rosenthal. She was raised in Napa attending Salvador Elementary School and Napa High School. After graduation, she worked for a short time in San Francisco at Joseph Magnin. In 1950, she traveled to New York City to visit family, and, in turn, met her future husband, George. Married in 1951, they continued in the family business of Rosenthal's Fresh Ranch Eggs, which later changed to the Rosenthal's Dried Fruit and Nut business, which is now known as Napa Nuts. In 1953, both Lottie and George along with several other families co-founded Congregation Beth Shalom where she was an active member for more than 50 years.
