Marjorie Olson, of Carson City, Nevada, formerly of Napa, passed away on December 8, 2020 at Skyline Estates Assisted Living in Carson City.

Marjorie was born on November 7, 1924 to Franklin and Margaret Ratliff. She was living in Santa Rosa, California when she met and later married her late husband Freeman Olson after his return from service in the U.S. Army during World War II. They were married in Reno, Nevada on January 4, 1946.

Freeman and Marjorie moved and lived in Freeman's hometown of Warren, Minnesota for several years before finally moving to Napa. Although they never had any children, Marjorie and Freeman helped raise two of their nieces during the years Freeman worked at the Mare Island Naval Shipyard.
