Phyllis Mae Burns Moore Napa, California Phyllis B. Moore, a long-time resident of Napa, died on May 20, 2013 at the age of 85. She was born on March 15, 1928 in Leipsic, Ohio, the daughter of Madison Pierre Burns and Ethel Mae Hoffman. The family soon moved to Toledo, Ohio where Phyllis graduated from DeVilbiss High School in 1946. Phyllis met her future husband, Richard Moore (Dick), when she was fifteen years old by encouraging her father to invite a wartime sailor home after church for Sunday dinner. She corresponded with Dick throughout his tour in the Navy and reconnected with him in California in 1947. They were married in Napa on May 16, 1948 and made Napa their home. Phyllis earned an AA Degree from Napa College in 1963, where she was later employed and retired as Assistant Manager of the College Bookstore. Phyllis volunteered as a Boy Scout Den Mother, Mother's Club member and a Campfire Girls Leader. She was a member of the Silver Spray Chapter of the Order Eastern Star; past Board Member for Rainbow for Girls, Napa #7; member of D.A.R. (Daughters of the American Revolution); Napa Genealogical Society; Presbyterian Women and other various Church groups. Phyllis is survived by her husband of 65 years, Richard Paul Moore, three children: Thomas (Karen Morgenstern), Ruth (Bruce Collier), Robert (Miyoko Ono-Moore), and six grandchildren: Jason Denman, Colin Ono-Moore, Kikumi Ono-Moore, Stephanie Collier, Rob Collier, and Nicholas Moore, plus great-grandchild, Jakob Denman.
