



Seyed Reza Tabarsi

Seyed Reza Tabarsi (1928-2018) passed away peacefully on January 13 in Napa, California. He was beloved by all who came to know him for his kindness and sense of humor. He was born in Tehran, Iran, growing up during the depression and WWII. Reza loved theater in the complete sense of it. Whether he was reenacting the adventures of Rostam from the Shahnameh for the neighborhood kids, or much later in life bluffing bank presidents to obtain a bigger loan for the multi-national corporations he represented, he relished the stage. He graduated from Dar'AlFunoon, the prestigious institute of higher learning, in Business Administration. For a brief period in his late teens to early twenties, he was a radio announcer broadcasting the daily news. He took an early retirement from the Ministry of Revenue and Taxation, to become a financial consultant. Reza immigrated to the US in order to oversee his children's education, in the process becoming a proud American citizen in 1996. He was an affectionate and loving grandfather, teaching the grandkids Persian nursery rhymes and spoiling them with sweets. Reza loved show business and the ritzy pizzazz it offered. He was always dressed to the T's. He had a dislike for any type of physical exertion that would cause him to sweat. He had a last-century love affair with perfumes and colognes and was singularly in love with Aramis. He leaves behind two sons; Sebastian and A. H. (spouse Lucia), two grandsons; Emiliano and Endeavor Tabarsi, and his sister Ghamar Zariv.
