Virginia Money Forloine passed away Wednesday, June 26, 2014 at the age of 94. Virginia was born February 13, 1920 to Cornelious C. and Zora Wilson Money in Napa. Both of her parents were born in Napa to early Napa pioneer families. Virginia attended local schools including John L. Shearer School of which her great-uncle was principle. She graduated from Napa High School with the class of 1938. She attended San Jose State College. Her first job was Deputy City Clerk, City of Napa. In 1943, Virginia joined the U.S. Navy, taking her basic training at Hunter College in New York, and her yeoman's training at Iowa State Teacher's College in Cedar Falls, Iowa. She was assigned duty at Livermore California Air Base Office, in charge of cadet training and later as a Confidential Communication Yeoman. She worked and fell in love with a Navy man, Clinton R. Forloine. They were married January 6, 1945. After the war, Clinton, Virginia and their son Clinton Jr. made their home in Napa. Clinton worked for 33 years for Napa City Police Department, retiring as Captain. Virginia worked 26 years for the Napa Valley Unified School District. She volunteered for 22 years with Community Projects. Virginia and Clinton spent a wonderful and happy 64 years together. Clinton preceded her in death. She is survived by her son Clinton C. Forloine and his wife Vicki, grandson Robert Forloine and his wife Kristan, great-grandsons Rylee and Kolton Forloine, her niece Carolyn and husband John Stewart and their 3 daughters and families.
